

## Terms and Conditions

Fees are payable monthly, and invoiced in advance, they must be paid on the 1st Holiday Club day of each month. Fees will be charged for days booked, fees will still be charged for absences while the Club is open.

You must ensure an alternative person is available to pick up your child should you not be able to arrive by 6:00pm as the school will close. Owing to alternative cover being necessary, a £5.00 per quarter hour charge will be made for any child not collected at the agreed time. Organised outings may incur an extra charge, Home from Home reserves the right to cancel the club should the minimum number of children not be reached on any one day.

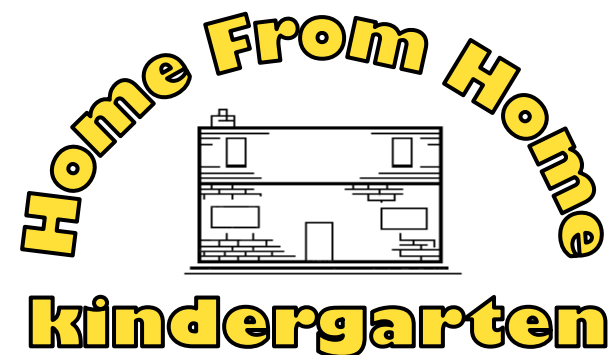
Holiday Club (Reception to year 6) ..... £32.00
